

The Strategy of Provincial Library on Managing Disability Service: Case Study of Modern Regional Library South East Sulawesi

Abstrak

Disability services in libraries at the provincial level are critical for promoting equal access, fostering inclusivity, and ensuring that libraries are welcoming spaces for everyone in the community, regardless of their abilities or disabilities. This study aims to identify the strategy of Modern Regional Library South East Sulawesi Province Library on Managing Disability Service. Thus, this study used a qualitative method. For qualitative data collection techniques, conducting interviews with librarians of Modern Regional South East Province and five librarians in that library. In conclusion, The first, the financial strategy carried out is good but currently Modern libraries have not focused on disability services which should also need attention. The second, the facility management strategy is also not optimal because the facilities provided are still very lacking while there are many visitors for disability services, especially from the Special School (Disability School) in Kendari city often send official letters to the library to make visits. Libraries need to create an inclusive and welcoming space for all members of the community. The third, libraries in charge of disability services are still lacking and there are no special librarians who can speak sign language. This indicates that libraries also need to maximize their Human Resources management strategies. Finally, the library organization development strategy actually has plans for disability services in the future and partners with the national library of Indonesia, and companies in the city of Kendari to improve disability services, but still needs careful planning so that in the future library services can be accessed by people with special needs with adequate facilities.

A. Introduction

A provincial library is a type of library establishment that is housed inside a nation's provincial government system. The people living in the province, are in charge of offering library services as well as access to a variety of resources and information. handicap services are crucial in the context of provincial libraries in

order to guarantee that all members of the community, regardless of ability or handicap, have equal access to and are welcomed in these inviting spaces. Naturally, a strong library management plan is required to enhance management. planning for the budget, facilities, human resources, and library needs to come first. As stated by Suzanne Heaven (2004) Library and information services lie at the heart of learning at every higher education institution and have both moral and legal obligations to ensure equitable access to both the building and its resources for all users. Adjustments to the physical premises alone are not enough, but with advancements in information and communication technology (ICT), equitable access must include Web-based materials, electronic journals, books and databases.

The Modern Regional Library of Southeast Sulawesi Province is one of the Provincial Libraries in Sulawesi which is a favorite library, has a design that is no less interesting, and has quite complete library facilities and collections. However, the current obstacle is that disability and elderly services are still combined in one room. Then collections for disability have not been served. The facilities provided are still very lacking. To answer all these problems, of course, a good management strategy is needed, starting from financial management, facilities and infrastructure, human resources, and organizational or library management. The purpose of this paper is to find out the management strategy of the Modern Regional Library Library, especially the Management Strategy on Disability services in the library.

B. Methods

The type of research used in this study is qualitative. Qualitative research is research shown to describe research results using theoretical foundations as a reference in analyzing research results. While the type of research used is a case study or case study. The case study formulated by Robert K. Yin, is a method that refers to research that has elements of how and why, on the main question of his research examining contemporary problems (present) in real life. The type of research used is the appropriate case study method delivered by Robert K Yin (2008). Case studies are used as a comprehensive explanation related to various aspects of a person, group, organization, program, or a community situation under study, to be pursued and examined as deeply as possible. Case studies also have the meaning of relating to detailed research of a person or a social unit within a certain period of time.

According to Yin (2008: 18) is an empirical inquiry that identifies phenomena in a real-life context. As the boundaries between phenomena and contexts are not clearly visible, and multiple sources of evidence are utilized. As an inquiry, case studies do not have to be conducted for a long time nor should they depend on ethnographic data or participant observations. The research subject provides research limitations such as objects, objects or people, which are added to

the research variable data discussed (Suharsimi Arikunto, 2016). In accordance with the title of this study, the target of this research is library study program students who have programmed their thesis.

In this study, informants are people who know well the problem under study and are willing to provide information to the researcher. According to Sutopo (2006: 179), qualitative research is research that leads to a detailed and in-depth description of both conditions and processes, and also the relationship or interrelation of the main things found in the research target So the informant chosen in this study is a librarian at a modern regional library.

Data collection techniques were used in the form of interviews, observations, and documentation studies. The three techniques are described as follows. The financial plan for 2014 is to focus on the development of the collection, Braille letters then the procurement of hearing aids, we also have a new how many seeds so, then that was the completeness of facilities and infrastructure, the vine handle then access to the 2nd floor there must be someone guarding below starting to get off from this, from what from the vehicle eee the door behind him so different from the general entrance room, Human resource development, librarians who serve disability services must be sign language courses, the second must know the use of tools, as well as special services for the disabled, we must provide capacity building for the disabled.(Herlina)

The function of the provincial library is as a library cooperation center in the area concerned and as a supervisor of all types of libraries in the province, as a regional deposit center, regional research center, and providing information, education, and science services to the wider community (Sutarno NS, 2006).
